The Lenten Prayer Garden has been prepared in the parish prayer space to assist in our focus on Lent. Our parish has been chosen by **Trocaire** in this their 40th anniversary year to host a Solar Lamp in our Prayer Space as a symbol of this parishes solidarity with some of the poorest and most marginalised people. It will serve as a symbol of our prayer and unity and a reminder of the constant presence of Christ who is the Light of the World.

Trocaire: This year Trocaire celebrates the 40th Anniversary of its founding. The focus of this year's Lenten Campaign is the isolated community of Jhilgoan in rural India. They have worked with the people of India since 1973. Over the 40 years the people have been empowered by Trocaire to work their way of poverty living lives of dignity and potential.
