Church Teaching

Is has been reported that there is no change to the law on abortion in Ireland.

The proposed legislation gives practical effect to the X Case decision ***which permits abortion up to birth where suicide is threatened.*** Ireland is about to cross a fundamental moral rubicon - the direct and intentional killing of the innocent.
