Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues from after Mass until 7pm each Tuesday in the Parish Centre. We are asking parishioners to consider giving even half an hour for quiet prayer and reflection before the Blessed Sacrament and to pray for Vocations.

MISSION SUNDAY: This Sunday the collection is taken to provide for those who live and work as missionary priests, religious and laity in foreign lands. This collection makes a huge contribution to assisting the Church in more challenging conditions around the world, in particular, where it is not easy to publicly practice one's belief in the Gospel. The Parish Apostolic Society will display their works in the Kingscourt church. In 2014, Irish Catholics donated more than €1.78m in parish appeals on Mission Sunday. This includes a contribution of €105,679 from the Diocese of Meath. There are currently around 1,300 Irish born missionaries serving throughout the world. Parishioners are invited to remember them in prayers and to pray for the communities where they work.

PRAYING FOR THE DEAD AND THE LIST OF THE DEAD:

Traditionally November is the month for commemorating our dead. In doing so we follow the sacred tradition since the earliest days of the Christian community to remember the dead at the Altar. That is why Catholics have a venerable tradition of having Masses offered for the souls of the departed. All Souls Day (2nd November) and the whole month of November are traditionally devoted to the Holy Souls. During the month of November and on the First Friday of each month, Masses will be offered for all those who have been included on the list. Please use the sheets and the purple envelope marked "List of the Dead" provided in your Parish Envelopes or simply use any envelope and write "List of the Dead" on it. Place your list, together with your donation/stipend in the steel boxes in our churches or into the Parish office.
