FEAST OF ALL SAINTS: As we celebrate this Solemnity we seek in particular the intercession of two of the Churches newest saints, the parents of St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Louis and St. Zelig Martin, whom Pope Francis canonised during the Synod on the Family. They were the first married couple to be canonised together and now may they be an inspiration to all married couples and their families.



PRAYING FOR THE DEAD AND THE LIST OF THE DEAD: All Souls Day (2nd November) and the whole month of November are traditionally devoted to the Holy Souls. During the month and on the First Friday of each month, Masses will be offered for all those who have been included on the list. Please use the sheets and the purple envelope marked "List of the Dead" provided in your Parish Envelopes or simply use any envelope and write "List of the Dead" on it. Place your list, together with your donation/stipend in the steel boxes in our churches or into the Parish office.

COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS: The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. All who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November.
