**FIRST FRIDAY:** This coming Friday is First Friday. Communion calls to the sick and housebound will be made during the coming week. Please contact the office if you know of someone who has not been able to get to Mass due to sickness or old age.

THE SACRAMENTS: This weekend we welcome as a group the children preparing for the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Communion. These days of Lent are important days for us all to grow in Faith and especially so for our children, within the home and within the parish. Make an effort to set a time every evening to pray, to be together as a family to reflect upon the presence of God in your lives at home and in the wonder of nature as signs of Spring and longer days emerge. With your children count down the days to Holy Week and talk about the events of Jesus' life in the Gospels which lead us to his entry into Jerusalem, his Last Supper, his trial and crucifixion, his burial and resurrection. As a family keep a focus on activities for Lent – to pray, to fast/abstain, to give! Remembering to first and foremost treat others as you'd like them to treat you and being merciful as God Our Father is merciful!
