Ireland prepares for WMOF2018 with international gathering

A special international conference was held on 1 June in DCU's The Helix, in preparation for the World Meeting of Families which will take place in Dublin in August 2018. Cardinal Kevin Farrell, Prefect of the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life, and Archbishop Diarmuid Martin of Dublin, President of World Meeting of Families 2018, were both speakers at this special event.

At the conference, Archbishop Martin said, "The World Meeting of Families will be a moment when we will speak of confidence, but also of realism stressing both the challenges and the joys of family life. The message of the World Meeting must be that the Church wishes to be close to families, especially those who experience challenge."

Pope Francis appoints Father Alan McGuckian as Bishop of Raphoe

Pope Francis has appointed Father Alan McGuckian SJ as the new Bishop of Raphoe, replacing Bishop Philip Boyce OCD who has retired. Father McGuckian will be the first bishop in Ireland to be appointed from the Society of Jesus. Archbishop Eamon Martin of Armagh said that Father McGuckian's background in education and communications, as well as his experience in pastoral planning and development with the Diocese of Down & Connor, reflect his rich experience and gifts. Archbishop Eamon also paid tribute to outgoing Bishop Philip Boyce acknowledging his supportive role and dedicated membership of the Irish Episcopal Conference since 1995.
