ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE RE OPENING OF CHURCHES FOR MASS AND SERVICES

A VERY WARM WELCOME HOME THIS WEEKEND!

- ❖ A Support Team is in place.
- ❖ Our Churches are cleaned to a high standard and are sanitised between consecutive services. Bathroom facilities are not available at the churches for the present. There is clear signage and sanitising materials are available in the Churches at liturgical services. ***We recommend you Use the Sanitizers as you Enter this weekend.***
- ❖ ***We encourage families and households to sit together in Church. Try coming a few minutes early! The uses of Face Covering in the indoor settings of Church is recommended.***
- ❖ The distribution of Holy Communion will be done in an orderly fashion. Exiting of the Church is also recommended in an orderly manner.
- ❖ A sign of peace can be offered in a manner which avoids physical contact.
- ❖ Mechanisms for Church collections are in place.
- ❖ Is recommended that people who are vulnerable or unwell and especially those with any symptoms, cough/fever/altered taste, breathlessness or flu like symptoms which might suggest Covid 19 or awaiting test results should ***Stay at Home*** and, participate as now via webcam for Mass.
- ❖ Altar servers will not participate at Masses until advised at a later date.
- ❖ The presentation of the Gifts of Bread and Wine is discontinued at the present.
- ❖ Hand contact with surfaces should be kept to a minimum!

The patience, continued perseverance and self sacrifice of all will still be needed in the time ahead. We once again acknowledge all our frontline professionals, and especially all from our own parish.
