<p>Revision of the Lectionary:</p>	<p>The Irish Episcopal Conference considered a revision of the lectionary for Mass earlier this year. Discussing the various options, they decided that the Revised New Jerusalem Bible could be the basis for a new edition of the Lectionary for Mass. The latest edition of the much-loved translation is in clear succession to the earlier editions. While all liturgical change runs the risk of being traumatic, thus would retain a lot of familiar phrases and cadences. New scholarship and language issues would be addressed, but the translation would be in clear continuity with the present one. Before moving forward with the process, they decided that it was important to hear the opinions of the Catholics of Ireland. The Bishops’ Conference is now seeking submissions from interested parties to its secretariat for liturgy, and these can be sent to liturgy@iecon.ie.</p>
