Parish Columbarium:	<p>In 2021 the parish held extensive consultation on proposals to mark the sesquicentennial anniversary of the church. This proposal has been worked on extensively by the Parish Finance Committee in the last number of months. A Columbarium Wall design, prepared by Niall Smith Architects, is on display in the church, on our website and on social media. The Columbarium will be prepared and erected by Tully Memorials and McKenna Engineering in late summer.
