A special Triduum of Masses has been planned to conclude the 150^{th} Anniversary of the Church from $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ December. They also reviewed the recent diocesan norms for pastoral practice forwarded from the Diocesan Office, noting in particular, the non-feasibility of the current number of weekend Masses in every parish, given the declining numbers in an ageing clergy and the need to ensure prayerful and quality liturgies.
